Stampin' Up! Supplies:

- STAMPS – Here's A Card Cling Stamp Set [149438]
- PAPER – Coastal Cabana 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [131297], Grapefruit Grove 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [146972], Whisper White 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [100730], Basic Black 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [121045], Birthday Bonanza Designer Series Paper [151313]
- INK – Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad [132708], Daffodil Delight Light Stampin' Blends Marker [144586]
- OTHER –Scalloped Tag Topper Punch [133324], Balloon Bouquet Punch [140609], Banner Triple Punch [138292], Silver 3/8" Metallic-Edge Ribbon [144213], Country Club Twine Combo Pack [151318], Rhinestone Basic Jewels [144220], Mini Glue Dots [103683], Stampin' Dimensionals [104430]

Cutting & Scoring:

- Coastal Cabana Cardstock - 11" x 4 1/4", score and fold at 5 1/2"
- Basic Black Cardstock – 5 1/4" X 1"
- Whisper White Cardstock – 2" X 4 3/4" (the punch will cut off 3/4")
- Grapefruit Grove Cardstock – scrap piece to punch out the largest balloon
- Birthday Bonanza DSP – 5" X 2 1/4"

Instructions:

- Adhere the DSP to the left side of the cardbase.
- Use the Triple Banner Punch on one end of the black cardstock to punch out a fishtail and adhere (refer to photo for placement) OR you can use scissors to make your own fishtail banner
- Use the Scalloped Tag Punch on one end of the white cardstock
- Stamp the Happy Birthday on the white cardstock tag and adhere to the card with Dimensionals (refer to photo for placement)
- Use a scrap piece of Grapefruit Grove cardstock to punch out the large balloon using the Birthday Balloon punch & adhere to the tag
- Tie a bow with Black Bakers Twine and adhere to the balloon with a mini glue dot
- Use the Light Daffodil Delight Stampin Blend to color the Silver Edged Ribbon before tying it into a knot and adhere to top of tag with a glue dot
- Add 3 rhinestones for embellishment (optional)
- Note: I used a White Gel Pen to add a white highlight to the balloon – not a Stampin Up! product
